

Melanoma Institute Australia & Jay's Longest Melanoma March 2019 Raffle

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. Information on how to enter and the prize form part of these Terms and Conditions. Participation in this raffle is deemed acceptance of these Terms and Conditions.
2. Entry is only open to Australian residents aged 18 years or over. Tickets sales are not permitted to residents of Western Australia, due to raffle licence restrictions.
3. To enter the raffle, individuals must complete the following steps during the raffle sales period: (a) Purchase a ticket from a Jay's Longest Melanoma March "Road Crew" member or from a Melanoma Institute Australia staff member present at the participating Melanoma March events or online via the RaffleTix.com.au website. (b) Input the requested details including their first name, last name, valid email address, contact number and address. (c) The raffle ticket will be provided to the purchaser shortly after payment is successfully processed. The purchase cost of each raffle ticket is \$10.00.
4. Raffle commences on 1st March 2019 and ends at 8.00pm AEDST on 19th May 2019.
5. There is a maximum of 10, 000 tickets available to be sold.
6. The draw will take place on 19th May 2019 at 9.00pm AEDST at Randwick Race Course, Alison Road, Randwick NSW 2031.
7. The Promoter reserves the right, at any time, to verify the validity of entries and entrants (including an entrant's identity, age and place of residence) and to disqualify any entrant who act otherwise than in accordance with these Terms and Conditions or who tampers with the entry or draw process. Errors and omissions may be accepted at the Promoter's discretion. Failure by the Promoter

to enforce any of its rights at any stage does not constitute a waiver of those rights.

8. The first valid entry drawn will win a Toyota Yaris Ascent (colour Red) with automatic transmission. Total prize value is from AU\$20,934 including registration, compulsory third party insurance, stamp duty and dealer delivery charges (which may vary State by State). Additional insurance, options, petrol and all other ancillary costs are the responsibility of the winner. The Promoter will liaise with the winner to arrange collection of the prize from a Toyota Dealership in mainland Australia at no cost to the winner.

If the winner is, through any legal incapacity or otherwise, unable to register the car in their own name, then the winner may assign the car to another person (who consents to such assignment) with legal capacity for the purpose of registration. The Promoter takes no responsibility for any such arrangements between the winner and the assignee. 11. If for any reason the winner does not take the prize at the time stipulated by the Promoter, then the prize will be forfeited and will not be redeemable for cash.
